Origin: Request of Council

Background:

It is a request of Council that the municipal land on Dwight Beach Road, on which the original municipal office was located before being destroyed by fire on November 26, 1996 be named "Gouldie Park" after Dwight's original settler, Edmund J. Gouldie, who donated the land in 1897 for the first school in Dwight, the Franklin S.S. # 3 Public School.

To complete this request staff has included Gouldie Park in Schedule B of By-law 08-10 under the List of Parks.
