#### **1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

#### **2. INTRODUCTIONS**

The Task Force and assembled public was introduced to the broader representation of Sue Smith, Lonnie and Peter Rumney, Bob Ransom, Marg & Brad Legg, Stephen Watson and Mike Wilmon.

**3. DISCUSSION**

The group was circulated copies of the October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2009 Council report "Proposed Norway Point Park Improvements". The following resolution that was subsequently passed by Council was also made available.

Be it resolved that the Council for the Township of Lake of Bays hereby accepts the staff report dated October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2009 "Proposed Norway Point Park Improvements" and directs staff to establish terms of reference and broaden the representation on the Norway Point Task Force to propose a viable alternative for the multi-use facility for consideration in the 2010 budget.

Terms of reference were to be established. Due to the number of individuals opposed to the improvements, no terms of references were able to be established.

**4. ISSUES/CONCERNS**

The majority of the public in attendance were opposed to the improvements to Norway Point and raised the following concerns for their opposition:

- Removal of vegetative island to expand parking area.
- No guest passes to be issued.
- Water lot lease may be required for dock expansion.
- Municipality in the marina business with permit system.
- Who would be eligible for permit?

The general public were advised to submit written correspondence to Council for December 8, 2009 outlining their concerns.
