The almost 1200 mile round-trip and my health prevent me from attending the upcoming meeting, but I want to state very clearly that I fully support the objectives and the specifics of the island residents seeking resolution of the parking and docking problems at the Norway Point municipal park area off Old Highway 117.

The shocking vandalism that occurred there last summer was in blatant violation of the LOBA purpose statement; "to promote . . . a safe, peaceful Lake of Bays." We have enjoyed the serenity there for over twenty years.

While on a global scale, there are far worse forms of terrorism, the damage to the vehicles was a form of terrorist coercion, and criminal, and could have had potentially tragic consequences.

I have been impressed by the concerted effort of my fellow islanders to work toward a mutually satisfactory solution. As a taxpayer and a Canadian citizen, I trust that the municipal authorities in co-operation with well-intended citizens can achieve a fair and equitable manner of dealing with the real problems both with docking and parking.

Thank you all for the effort that has gone into supplanting the ugliness of last summer with good sense and goodwill.
