Dear Mayor Peake and Councillors,

At its meeting of June 16 the Lake of Bays Library Board reviewed recent progress on our Baysville expansion. As you know we are now open for business in our newly expanded building. The Board and staff at Baysville want to take this opportunity to thank Council for your support in bringing this dream to a reality. Your support, both financial and political, is most appreciated.

During our review of progress we discussed plans for an official opening ceremony. We understand that there has been some discussion at Council about an event on August 22. While we fully appreciate the scheduling pressures of the busy summer season, we would ask that an earlier date be chosen. Late July or earlier in August would be our preference. We also recommend that we avoid Saturdays – Thursdays or Mondays would be better days of the week.

We want to provide an opportunity for as many township residents – seasonal as well as permanent – to participate in the opening. We are also concerned, of course, that we are able to acknowledge the contributions of our many donors without whose support the project would not have been possible. A date later in August may not afford this opportunity. By then people have already started to think about getting back into their fall routines. Likewise Saturdays are days when folks are busy with family and guests and may not want to come out to a civic event.
