



Winter Driving Emergency Tips

Winter is here, so here are some tips to help you cope

- ❖ Pay attention to weather warnings from your local weather offices or Environment Canada. Check out the website at www.weatheroffice.ec.gc.ca
- ❖ Winterize your vehicle; take it for a winter tune up.
- ❖ Check tire pressure, cold weather decreases tire pressure.
- ❖ Ensure windshield wipers are in good condition, and your washer fluid is full. Carry an extra jug of washer fluid in your vehicle.
- ❖ Try to keep fuel tank at least ½ full.
- ❖ Clear all snow from the hood, roof, windows and lights.
- ❖ If stuck in a storm or snow-bank, run your motor sparingly, ensure tailpipe is not blocked by snow, allow fresh air to enter car.
- ❖ Drive according to weather conditions!
