Section 5.1.1 i) Maximum Lot Coverage – 10%	13.3%	To permit a maximum lot coverage of 15.8%
Section 5.1.1 d) Minimum Shoreline Yard Setback – 30 metres (98.4 ft.)	16.5 metres (54 ft.) to a legal non-complying dwelling	To permit a minimum shoreline yard setback of 16.5 metres (54 ft.) to an open and unenclosed deck

Section 5.1.1 l) Maximum Shoreline Activity Area Coverage – 40%	38.6% (legal boathouse structure)	To permit a maximum shoreline activity area coverage of 78.9 sq. m. (849 sq. ft.), or 41.4%
Section 5.1.1 k) Maximum Shoreline Activity Area Frontage – 25%	9.1 metres (30 ft.) (legal boathouse structure)	To permit a maximum shoreline activity area frontage of 10.4 metres (34 ft.), or 27.2%

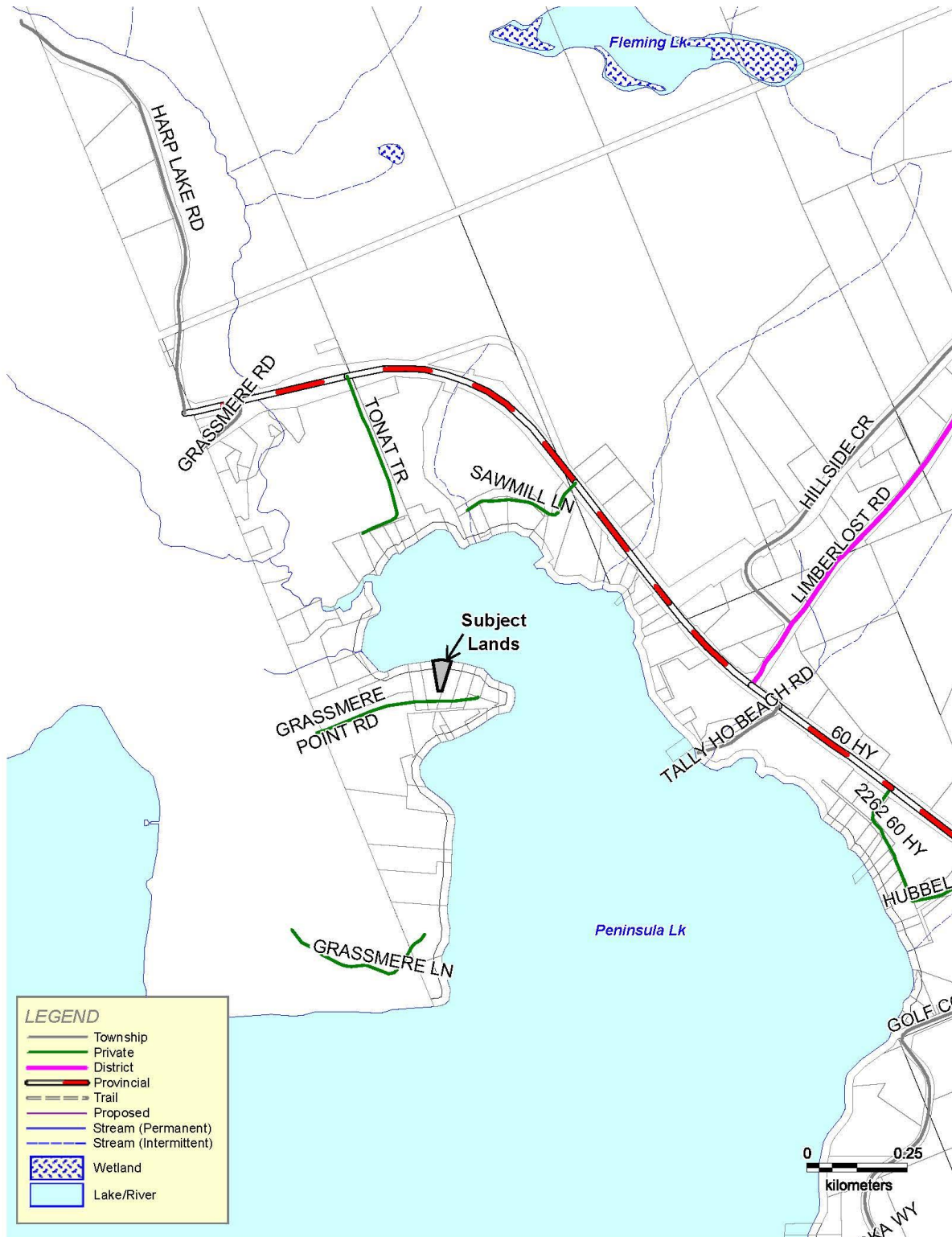

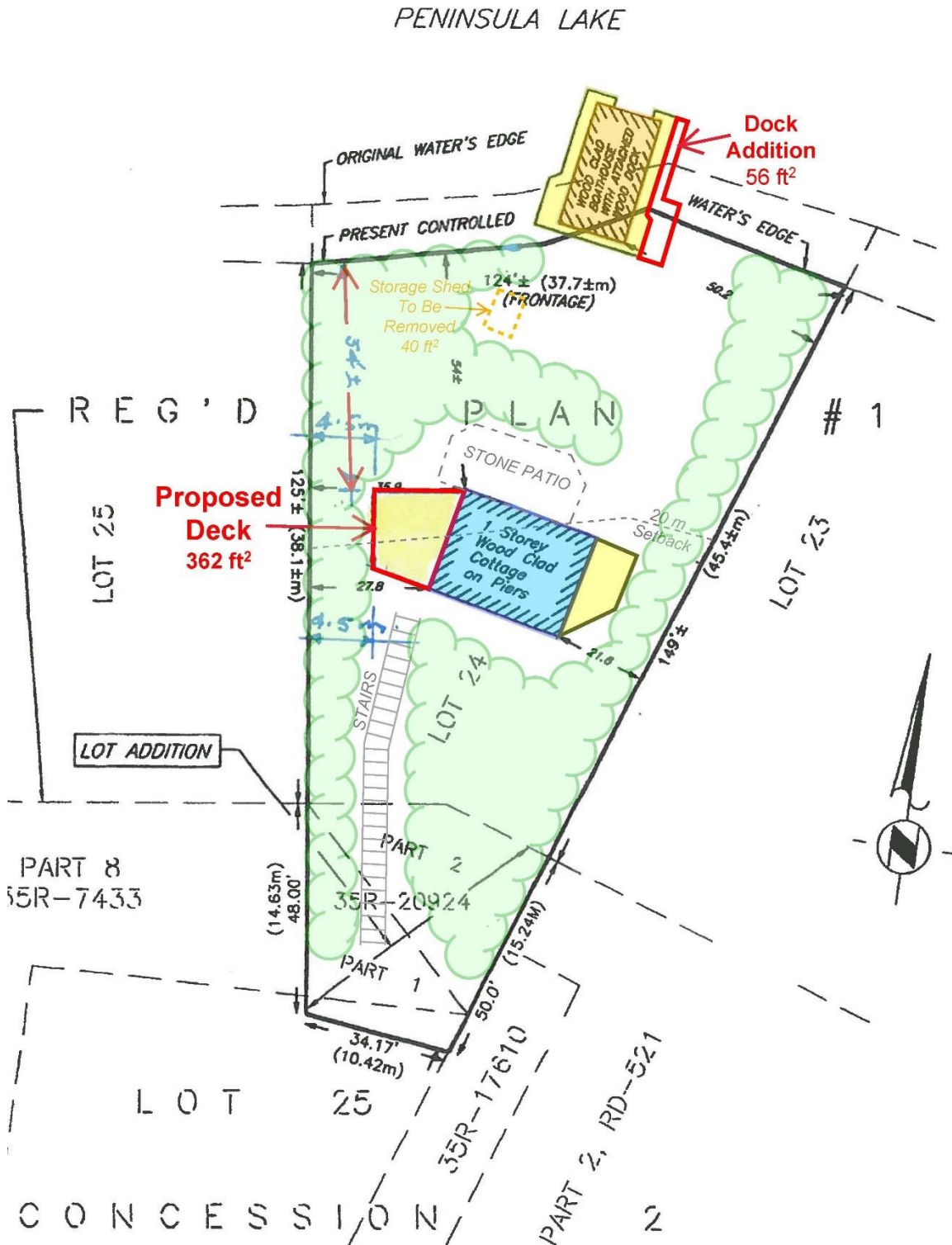
Location Map
